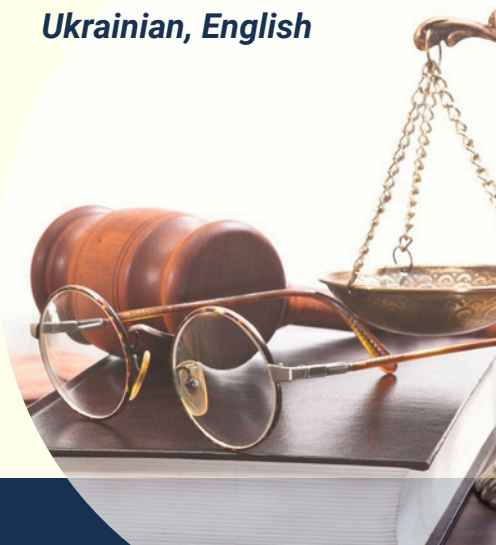

## Requirements for the design of a scientific publication

1. Volume – **5-8 pages**. Page format – **A4 (297x210 mm)**, book orientation.
2. Margins: all **20 mm**; Font – Times New Roman, Font Size – **14**, line spacing – **1.5**, style – Normal.
3. The first line is the title of the report (bold font, all capitals, centered).
4. The second line is the surname and first name (bold italic font, aligned in the center).
5. Abstract (**2-3 sentences**) and keywords (**up to 5**) in Ukrainian.
6. The text of a research paper, aligned in width with an indentation on the left of **10 mm**.
7. Sources (placed at the end of the text and must be formatted in accordance with the existing bibliographic description APA standards version 7.0).
8. Abstract (**2-3 sentences**) and keywords (**up to 5**) in English.
9. Author's certificate (name, scientific degree, academic title, position, Orcid)
10. References in the text must be written with APA standards version 7.0.
11. The author is responsible for the scientific accuracy and reliability of the materials, as well as the accuracy of the quotes, figures, and names provided.
12. The organizing committee reserves the right to edit received scientific publications.
13. Materials that do not meet the established requirements will not be considered.
